GENERAL RULES

1. **Entry restricted to amateurs**
2. **Only one entry per class is permitted per person**
3. **All exhibits, except the Floral Art section, to have been grown or made by exhibitor**
4. **Pot plants to have been in the possession of exhibitor for 6 months**
5. **The Committee shall appoint judges whose decisions are final. Judges will be guided by the RHS Horticultural Show Handbook, but may use their discretion**
6. **The Committee shall take all ordinary care of exhibits, but cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage incurred**
7. **Trophies will be presented at the show, taken for engraving and then be held by the committee**
Winners will receive a wooden plaque, in recognition of their success in the show
